1 : Features of the NOMAD CHAIR

Weight : 12 kilograms

3 : Security rules

- When seating the user, make sure they do not step on the footrest to prevent the chair from tipping forward.
- When folding the chair, ensure all locking pins are fully secured before transport to avoid sudden opening.
- Only adults may handle the chair.
- Children must be supervised at all times when the chair is in use.
- Handle the chair carefully to avoid injuries or finger pinching.
- For safe storage, when the NOMAD CHAIR is folded, place it on the ground with its wheel module to prevent damage or falling. Set it on a flat and stable surface.
- The NOMAD CHAIR can support a maximum load of 130 KG.
- Keep the chair away from heat sources such as fire, barbecues, and cigarettes.
- Do not expose the chair to prolonged sunlight.

4 : Our ergonomomy settings advices

- Product Height Adjustment :
 - Place the product at the right height so that your arm stays aligned with your body and your elbows form a 90-degree angle while working.
 - Cut the top section of the hair first.
 - Then raise the foot setting by one level above the initial position to work on the sides and/or beard service.
 - When adjusting the foot area, keep your back straight and bend your knees toward the floor. (See adjustment video)
- Footrest Adjustment :
 - Ask the client if the footrest height suits them.
 - When lying down, it is recommended to raise the footrest one notch to remove the curve in the lower back (more comfortable for the client).
- Headrest and Incline Adjustment :
 - Ask the client if the position feels comfortable.
 - Depending on the person, some will prefer the headrest under the neck or under the head.
 - For overweight clients, recommend sitting slightly forward and using only the lowest incline to avoid discomfort.

5 : Maintenance

If hair gets under the cushions, simply remove the upholstery to clean it.
If you spill any chemical product on the item, please clean it as quickly as possible.

LEATHER

A natural material that develops character over time.

It is sensitive to heat, direct sunlight, water, and skin oils, which can alter its surface and cause discoloration or stains.

Clean with a damp cloth lightly soaked in Marseille soap.

Do not apply polish or greasy products.

Use a spray designed for delicate leather care.

After each cleaning, protect it with a waterproofing spray made for this purpose.

Periodically, have it dry-cleaned by a specialist.

VEGAN LEATHER

Clean spills as quickly as possible with a soft cloth soaked in warm water and non-detergent soap.

Wipe gently using circular motions.

After cleaning, let it air-dry.

5 : Maintenance

ARTIFICIAL LEATHER

- Keep imitation leather away from water.
- Clean gently with small circular motions.
- A simple home method: cleansing milk on a cotton pad. Add a little white vinegar for deeper cleaning and extra shine.
- White vinegar can also be mixed with soapy water to clean the surface.

POWDER-COATING AND CARBON

- Wash with soapy water.
- After washing, rinse well with clean, additive-free water.
- Avoid gasoline, acetone, alcohol, alkaline or acidic products, sanding sponges, abrasives, and high-pressure jets.
- Do not leave under direct sunlight for long periods.

HARDWARE

- Check screw tightness regularly. Transport vibrations may weaken the thread glue. If so, contact after-sales support.
- Anti-slip pads on the product's feet can be removed.

6 : The warranty

The NOMAD CHAIR have a 3 year warranty under condition of a normal use. You can find the details of the warranty conditions in the GTC available on the website www.cadillacstorepro.com.
